NOTES for REPLACEMENT VEHICLES

- If a replacement vehicle is to be licensed, the licence plate and window sticker must be removed from the damaged vehicle and returned to the Council.
- The replacement vehicle must be presented to the licensing officer (by appointment) with an application form, new MOT test certificate, confirmation of insurance and change of vehicle fee. This is usually organised by the rental company, who pay the change of vehicle fee up-front for the damaged vehicle to be re-licensed after repair.
- When the repairs to the vehicle have been completed it will need to be re-licensed, by completing an application form, providing a new MOT, up to date insurance and presenting the vehicle for inspection (by appointment) at the Civic Centre.
