Wychavon District Council published public notice on 29 July 2019. Residents and interested organisations were invited to give their views options put forward by 9 September 2019.

**Draft Proposals**

Polling District	Proposed change
RKA, RKB (Bowbrook Ward)	Electors to vote at Himbleton Parish Hall instead of Oddingley Village hall which has closed.
DBEA (Droitwich Central Ward)	Electors to vote at Droitwich Community Hall, Heritages way instead the Legion Club which has closed.
DBN (Droitwich South East)	Electors to vote at the Mobile Unit, Red Lion, Worcester Road instead of Spring Meadow Public House which has closed.
BH (Evesham North)	Electors to vote at St Mary & St Egwin Church Hall instead of Red Cross Centre, Briar Close which has Closed
BFC & BD (Little Hampton)	Electors to vote at Evesham United Football Club, Cheltenham Road instead of Meta academy as room no longer available for rent.
NPA, NPB, NPB (Upton Snodsbury)	Electors to vote at White Ladies Aston Village hall instead of Spetchley Old School which is no longer suitable to use as a polling station due to lack of facilities.
ROB (Inkberrow)	Electors to vote at Hanbury Village hall instead of Stock and Bradley Village hall. Result will be that all electors will vote within the parish they live in.
