

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Parliamentary Election for the Redditch Constituency

1. An Election is to be held of One Member of Parliament for the Constituency of Redditch.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at Town Hall, Walter Stranz Square, Redditch, Worcs, B98 8AH from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Room G4A, Town Hall, Walter Stranz Square, Redditch, Worcestershire, B98 8AH on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm (excluding weekends and bank holidays) but **no later than 4 pm on Thursday, 14th November 2019.**
4. The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft drawn upon a bank operating in the United Kingdom.
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 12th December 2019.**
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes, in writing, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (Redditch Borough Council area) at Town Hall, Walter Stranz Square, Redditch B98 8AH and (Inkberrow Ward of Wychavon District Council) at Civic Centre, Queen Elizabeth Drive, Pershore WR10 1PT by **5 pm on Tuesday 26th November 2019.**
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (Redditch Borough Council area) at Town Hall, Walter Stranz Square, Redditch, B98 8AH and (Inkberrow Ward of Wychavon District Council) at Civic Centre, Queen Elizabeth Drive, Pershore WR10 1PT by **5 pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019.**
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election applied for on grounds of either physical incapacity or absence in relation to occupation, employment or service occurring after 5pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019 must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (Redditch Borough Council area) at Town Hall, Walter Stranz Square, Redditch, B98 8AH and (Inkberrow Ward of Wychavon District Council) at Civic Centre, Queen Elizabeth Drive, Pershore WR10 1PT by **5 pm on Thursday, 12th December 2019.** The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019.
