Notwithstanding all the other perfectly legitimate objections that will have been made by those most closely affected by this proposal, it is extraordinary that anyone can even consider putting houses, driveways, pavements, roads etc. on yet another greenfield site around Droitwich (currently and recently 100 acres and 740 homes at Copcut Rise and 70 acres and 765 homes, and rising, at Yew Tree Hill) when there is already huge concern over local infrastructure being able to cope.

There is too, of course, concern for the natural environment in general and in this case, also the historical environment, with the importance of preserving the environs of the local Church (a listed building) and its history and heritage.

This proposal might seem like just a small thing in a very big picture but we must all do a small thing if we are to succeed in protecting the environment.
