## SECTION 5 Policies for Broadway

It is acknowledged in the Plan (see Figure 28) that 61% of residents consider that there is not enough car parking space in the Village.

The proposal to use the Kennel Lane site (5.1.28, 5.1.29 and 5.1.34) for mixed use development refers to car parking spaces to be made available for site users only. If this is adopted existing High Street shop staff who park currently on the Kennel Lane site (currently approx 50 spaces could be available) will have to park elsewhere. This could impact on visitors to the Museum as visitors try to find a convenient car parking space.

Whilst the Broadway Museum gives its support to the Plan further consideration needs to be given to where shop keeper and visitor parking can be best located and incorporated within the Plan. Given the anticipated growth of the Village additional integrated parking will be needed.
