BROADWAY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN - REGULATION 16 CONSULTATION.

Thank you for the above consultation and invitation to comment on the Submission Neighbourhood Plan.

Our previous comments on the Regulation 14 Plan remain entirely relevant that is:

"Historic England is supportive of both the general content of the document and the vision and objectives set out in it. We commend the broad scope of the document and the good coverage afforded to the historic environment within it.

The emphasis on the conservation of local distinctiveness through good building design, including through the identification of discrete character areas and the protection of national and local heritage assets, local green space and important views, along with landscape character and biodiversity is to be applicated.

We also commend the Broadway Village Design Statement (2020) which is admirable in its detail providing an invaluable context for the Plan that will be of great assistance in guiding future development, as will the policy requirements for master plans for major developments and for the production of design codes all to be guided by design review.

In conclusion, the plan reads overall as a well written, well-considered and fit for purpose document. We consider that an exemplary approach is taken to the historic environment of Broadway and that the Plan constitutes a very good example of community led planning".
