#### **Summary**

Following an independent examination, Wychavon District Council now confirms that the Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan will proceed to a Neighbourhood Planning Referendum on Thursday 30 September 2021.

#### **Background**

On 29 August 2017, Wychavon District Council designated the area comprising the parishes of Ombersley and Doverdale as a Neighbourhood Area for the purposes of preparing a Neighbourhood Plan.

Extensive community consultation culminated in the draft Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan consultation which took place in October and November 2020. The consultation responses fed into the final version of the Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan which was submitted to Wychavon District Council in February 2021, along with the associated Consultation Statement, Basic Conditions Statement and SEA and HRA Screening Opinion.

The Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan and associated documentation was then publicised and representations were invited; the publicity period ended on 16 April 2021.

Wychavon District Council appointed an independent Examiner, Christopher Collison of Planning and Management Ltd, to review whether the Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan should proceed to referendum in May 2021.

Having considered each of the recommendations made by the Examiner's Report and the reasons for them, in consultation with the Parish Council, Wychavon District Council has decided to make the modifications to the draft Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan as detailed in Table 1 below in order to ensure the Plan meets the Basic Conditions as set out in the legislation.

#### **Decisions and Reasons**

Wychavon District Council has made the following modifications, as proposed by the examiner and agreed by the Parish Council, to ensure that the Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Plan meets the Basic Conditions.
