Green Space Policy

The Green Space policy is outdated and needs to be revised as follows:

- One area of proposed green space has already been granted planning consent for four houses.
- One area of proposed green space is currently being considered for planning for the provision of affordable homes.
- There are issues with Glebe Meadow being identified as green space as there are legal issues with the charitable trust under which the area is managed.

This is another symptom of the plan not being developed collaboratively with villagers and landowners. The Landowners whose land has been identified as green space have not been consulted, and many are not supportive of their land being included.

The amount of green space identified along the Winchcombe Road is also disproportionate to the green space in the central part of the village. Is it purely a coincidence that 90% of the Steering Committee members live in that area of the village?
