- 1.This is not the document that was sent out in hard copy to the village. It has been changed so many times by the current CPPC after some of the village voted to support it.
- 2.Having worked on the document myself, when the new CPPC came in, it was apparent to me that the document was being used to remove the travellers from the village. The language that was being used in my view was racist.
- 3. Only a handful of picked people have been able to have an input into the content of the NDP thus this gives a very biased view.
- 4. The current CPPC has been supported by Tatlow King particularly with the content of CP11. The interests of the whole village have been put to one side in their endeavour to encourage and support development in this area in order to get rid of the traveller site.
- 5. This document does not support the whole village: there is no provision for the travellers who do not want to leave the village and who have children in the local school.
- 6. In meetings we were told by CPPC, that if we do not support this document we would have an influx of Irish travellers and we would have a Dale Farm scenario. Pictures of Dale Farm were shown to villagers thus building panic, fear and hostility.
- 7. CP11 should be rejected .

1. This has been significantly changed from the agreed document that was sent out as a hard copy which some of the village supported.
2. This does not support the needs of the travellers who have lived side by side with the rest of the village for over 20 years. Wychavon has a shortage of sites and to close this one would be outrageous.
3. The travellers who have said they want to sell the land do not live on the site. What will happen to the ones who do not want to leave and have children in the local school and local area?
4. The new CPPC have let the land they own next to the CP11 area get into such a state to encourage support to close the site. It is a Health and Safety nightmare for any young person or animals to go onto the site. The CPPC have not spent any money making it safe nor added fencing and signs
5. A lot of time and money has been spent on CP11 but at no time have the needs of the travellers been considered. The time has been spent on ways and means to support Tatlow King and they plan solely to remove the travellers and to put housing on the site to make money.
