Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish you to record my very strong objections to the proposed development plans on the basis of non-sustainability. It is currently almost impossible to secure an appointment with a doctor and waiting times at the main hospital in Worcester are unacceptable. Hundreds of new houses are planned for SWDPR site ref. CFS0905sc and SFS0407sc, and also more are already approved at Newland and more are currently being built off St Andrews road in Malvern, but with no additional schools, children's nurseries, doctors surgeries, dentists, hospital beds, parking, sewage and wastewater capacity. The sewage system at Hall Green, Malvern is already at near breaking point and the sewage works at the bottom of Mill Lane, Malvern, built over 110 years ago, is also at full capacity. In addition the new houses proposed at site CFS0905sc will be very close to the Sewage works. I am extremely concerned that the proposed developments will have an extreme negative effect upon the quality of life for the residents already living on the East side of Malvern.

As someone who grew up in Malvern, spending over 20 years there, I care deeply about the potential impact of these developments.
