Infrastructure SWDPR09

I have serious concerns with respect to the Infrastructure implications for the employment and housing sites to the east of Malvern, specifically in relation to the sanitation, gas, and electricity. Also I wonder if the present schools have the capacity to accommodate the extra children. I think that is unlikely at Primary level especially, some children of Primary age have to be taken to school some distance away now, as the local Primary schools are at capacity now, which adds to the congestion. This means that roads like Clevelode Lane, a rural country road, will be inundated with traffic; even now at peak times it has nonstop traffic moving along it in both directions.

I do not regard the proposals for the housing and employment land with respect to the infrastructure as sound due to the serious adverse effect all this development would have on Malvern.
