SWDPR 06 Transport

I consider the proposed plan for Malvern to be unsound and would like to object in the strongest possible terms to sites CFS0407sc, CFS0905sc and CFS1191 on the Eastern boundary of Malvern [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. At peak times morning and evening, the traffic is virtually continuous with frequent disputes at the single lane end. I have now experienced four occasions when a large commercial vehicle comes up very close behind me, whilst I am keeping to the speed limit, blasts me with the horn, then drives with headlights on full beam in my rear windscreen with the horn blaring and repeatedly swinging out, trying to force his way past me to overtake. Eventually I give way, fearful he may run me off the road. All this as we approach a small blind spot at the top of a hill, with a vehicle possibly coming in the opposite direction. An increase in traffic will only exacerbate the problem.

At the top of Hall Green where it meets Chance Lane, a very narrow and potentially dangerous piece of road, on a blind bend on the one hand and one that carries heavy vehicles, both farming and commercial ones at all times of the day and night. For sites CFS0905sc/CFS1191 the Common will suffer irreversible damage by yet another right of way across it.

I regard the plans for the above identified housing proposals as unsound and contrary to SWDPR 06.
